

RE-DIRECT EXAMINATION OF MARIA BROEL PLATTER BY MR. McHANEY:

Q. Witness were you ever asked to sign a paper in Ravensbrueck, which would show that your injuries to your leg had occurred for reasons other than the operation, which you have described to this Tribunal?

A. I did not sign such a paper, but I was warned and told by Commander Tuchring, who wanted me to sign such a paper. The contents of this paper was as follows: "The undersigned, Marie Broel-Plater, certifies that the scars, which I have on my legs, were caused by an accident at work."

Q. I have no further questions to direct to the witness. I would like at this time, if there is no further cross-examination, to call Dr. Alexander to the stand and have him give his expert medical report on this witness.
